## INTERVIEW WITH

**What are your first impressions on the Winter Academy?**

First of all I would like to talk about the scientific programme, which I think it was perfectly organized:

the clinical research combined with the practical application can only benefit the patients. This combination is one of the major goals and in this congress I think it was achieved completely. Another important characteristic is the social programme: the location is beautiful, St. Moritz is a wonderful place. And we should not forget that the social activities are fundamental: you can meet old friends and make new ones, start important connections and alliances that could be very useful.

**What is the situation of medical education in Brazil?**

Brazil has almost 6000 dermatologists, as a matter of fact is the second largest dermatological association in the world. At the Annual Meeting of the American Academy of Dermatology that took place in Miami last March the Brazilian delegation was formed by more than 1000 delegates, and it was the largest delegation of the meeting. Brazil has high quality dermatologists, and the Brazilian Academy of Dermatology is an important factor since it gathers all of them, representing a unique point of reference for Tropical Diseases and also Aesthetics Dermatology.

**We know that you have a very interesting congressional event in Brazil, would you like to talk about it?**

Of course, the event is going to be very decisive. The idea is to start connections with dermatologists from all over the world, professionals from Brazil and also from a great variety of foreign countries. Moreover the location of the congress, which we decided to call First Summer Meeting of Dermatology, will be held in Salvador Bahia from 9 till 11 December 2010 which is one of the most important city in Brazil for culture, music, literature and culinary art. Finally I think that the support of the World Health Academy and of the Sociedade Brasileira de Dermatologia will be of fundamental importance in order to achieve all of our objectives.
